



Do's and don'ts...

- DO use dual factor authentication
- · DO call IT if you are unsure
- · DO call IT if you have clicked a link
- · DELETE if unsure; don't take risks
- DON'T forward dodgy stuff
- Use NCSC: report@phishing.gov.uk
- DON'T use personal email accounts
- · Rather ask if you are unsure
- The most important thing: tell IT!
