



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

1st July 2021 – 16th August 2021

By entering the Competition, you agree to the provisions of these Terms and Conditions and to comply fully with them.

- A theme for your photograph should be chosen from the following:
 - *Generations*
 - *Tea and cake*
 - *Almshouse pride*
 - *Happiness*
 - *Flora and fauna*
 - *Through the garden gate*
- All entries must be in before **4pm on Monday 16th August 2021** to be considered.
- To be eligible, members and residents must email their photos in jpeg format to The Almshouse Association to gerryharmon@almshouses.org. There will be one winner overall and one runner up.
- The winner and runner up will be decided by several judges, including a professional photographer.
- The judge's decision is final.
- The winner and runner up will be announced at The Almshouse Association's afternoon tea garden party on the 8th September.
- The winner and runner up will be notified the week commencing the 13th September 2021.
- The winner will receive a Dobbie's Garden Voucher and a framed certificate.
- The runner up will receive a framed certificate.
- If you are under the age of 18 you must have permission to enter the Competition from your parent or guardian. By submitting an entry for the competition, your parent/carer/guardian is deemed to have given such consent and to agree to the use of the entry as described in these terms and conditions.
- If your photograph features any person or people, they should be aware that they are being photographed and permission should be obtained from all involved (or their parents/guardians permission if under 16) for their photograph to be submitted in the competition. If it is clear that the people are not aware of their picture being taken or are embarrassed in any way by any entry we receive, The Almshouse Association reserves the right to disqualify the entry.
- Copyright and reproduction - You must be the sole author and owner of the images entered. You will be credited alongside your picture in any promotion activity undertake during and after the competition closes.
- The Almshouse Association reserves the rights to all photos entered in the competition.
- Usage Rights - By entering your images into the competition, you grant The Almshouse Association exclusive license to reproduce the images for any purpose.
- Data Protection - The information you provide will be collected and stored by The Almshouse Association and processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. We will only use your information for the purposes of administration of the Competition (including publishing your name if you are a winner) and any other purposes to which you have consented. We will not pass your details on to any third party.



- Indemnity and Limitation of Liability - To the maximum extent permitted by law, The Almshouse Association excludes its liability for any loss, damage, injury, cost or expense suffered by you, whether directly or indirectly and howsoever caused, in connection with the Competition.
- Nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall exclude The Almshouse Association's liability for death or personal injury arising from The Almshouse Association's own negligence or any other liability that cannot, as a matter of law, be excluded.
- You agree to indemnify The Almshouse Association and keep The Almshouse Association indemnified against any loss, damage, injury, cost or expense suffered by The Almshouse Association as a result of your entry in the Competition, including (but not limited to) any claim of infringement of intellectual property rights made by any third party.
- You agree that if you are a winner, you will take part in and cooperate fully with reasonable publicity and to the use of your name and photograph in such publicity.
- The Almshouse Association reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time through The Almshouse Association website without giving notice.
